## HAPPENINGS ON THE HILL

The last several months have been busy at the shelter. Since the beginning of the year we have assisted 74 people with emergency shelter, food, and other assistance needed to start them back in the right direction. We have coordinated with other agency's to improve our service's in Highland County related to homelessness. We also are working on a regional level to streamline services to better assist people that are at-risk of becoming homeless, and to aide them in re-housing themselves and divert them from shelter if possible. Changes will continue and we will always be involved in leading the way to better serve the at-risk population in and around Highland County. With this said, none of this would be possible without the continued support of the many people, churches, and businesses locally that donate to our cause. We cannot thank you enough for your generosity.

Examples of this giving have been in abundance this spring. The Homemaker's Show in April provided us with over a ton of food to help fill our pantry. Several churches have been doing necessity drives to collect the daily use items that we need each day. Some churches have made financial contributions, and are even having motorcycle rides to raise money for the shelter. Many businesses have donated and supported us this spring, as seen from the recent support for our golf scramble. We still need more financial support to match funds for our grants, and to operate and maintain the shelter.
